Re: EasyJet plc

Thank you for your letter dated 30 April.

1. We must assume that some advice was given to the board and chairman of easyJet in connection with the preparation of the (purported) notice of meeting, including some advice touching upon the matters raised by our letter of yesterday. Accordingly, we see no good reason for you to delay providing us with a substantive response.
2. The indicated delay in your providing that response is prejudicial to our clients' interests.
3. You do, however, indicate your position to the effect that the purported notice is valid and that the purported meeting will be valid. We disagree.
4. We therefore anticipate that your substantive response will not contain constructive proposals to address our clients concerns, as we have requested.
5. Accordingly our client is now minded to proceed to convene a general meeting of easyJet PLC in accordance with the Companies Act 2006 section 305 as his right given that the directors of easyJet plc have failed to call a meeting in accordance with section 304.
