EASYJET'S ALL-IN IS HOL WIN

MORE holidaymakers are opting for all-inclusive packages so they can plan their budgets, according to the boss of **EASYJET**.

The low-cost carrier yesterday reported a "record bounceback" in travellers after pandemic restrictions were lifted, helping easyJet to narrow losses from £1.1billion last year to £178million.

The airline carried 70million passengers over the past 12 months, three-and-a-half times more than the previous year, which helped revenues to rebound from £1.5billion to £5.8billion.

Chief Johan Lundgren said about 65 per cent of its summer trips were all-inclusive, 30 per cent higher than last year.

The airline was hit with £78million in compensation over disrupted flights in the summer chaos but Mr Lundgren said he was "confident" that airports were set-up for the winter rush.
